Palma de Mallorca (25mins drive from wedding reception)



Capital of Mallorca, a coastal resort city. The La Seu Cathedral is Palma's landmark and must be visited on your trip to Mallorca. Additionally Castell de Bellver is a beautiful castle with stunning views over the city and mediterranean to add to the visit list.

Other main attractions are the emblematic Passeig del Borne Avenue, the bustling Olivar market, the Basilica of Sant Francesc, the gorgeous Sa Llotja building and the Plaza Mayor.

For shopping you will find everything you need on the Jaume III avenue, but don't miss out on the Santa Catalina neighbourhood which is filled with some of the city's best, most fashionable bars and restaurants.

Colonia de Sant Jordi - Popular destination for beach lovers, who are after a vibrant resort town. The coast line here is known for the beautiful (almost) white sandy beaches and turquoise waters.

Santa Catalina - Neighborhood within the old town of Palma. It is one of the city's most appealing areas – with the ambiance of a village combining old and contemporary characteristics and lifestyles. Perfect spot for foodies

Cala Major - Purpose built beach resort close to the centre of Palma. Lots of options for family friendly beach resort hotels. Also the location of Marivent Palace which is the holiday home for the Spanish royal family
